Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time—A Ministry of Forgiveness. Jesus more than heals. He forgives us. The story of God’s care for His people began with Isaiah’s proclamation of salvation of God’s part, and continues into the present. It is a story of salvation or rescue, the forgiveness of sin, and newness. God’s love for His people is eternal even though their sinfulness has made them unworthy of His love. God makes no bones about our sinfulness, but He likes to do new things. He likes us to say as we do before we receive Holy Communion, “I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof, but only say the word and my soul shall be healed.” As St. Paul says, Jesus is the eternal “Yes” of God.
